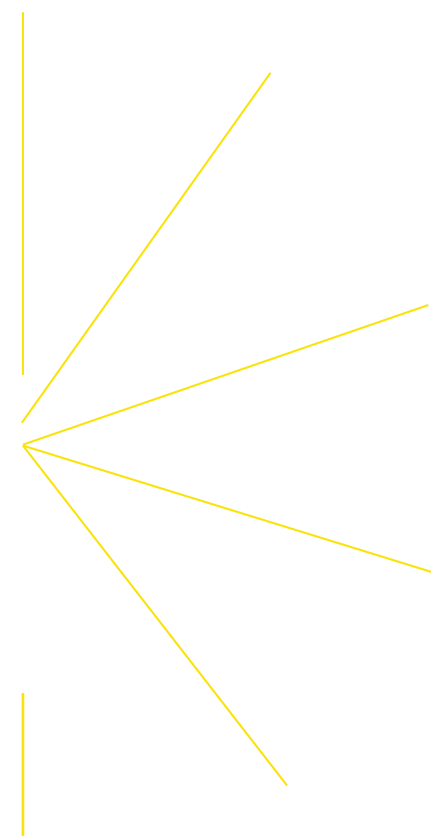

This vital regeneration marks the beginning of a new era for Leeds Bradford Airport.

This programme represents the culmination of thousands of hours of planning, consultation, design and review, focused on delivering a facility that supports the delivery of an outstanding customer experience, an efficient operation and a sustainable aviation future.

The +£100m investment in regenerating LBA will deliver the airport that Yorkshire needs and deserves. It will also allow us to futureproof LBA, delivering the additional capacity and connectivity our region needs with new technologies to streamline and enhance the customer journey.

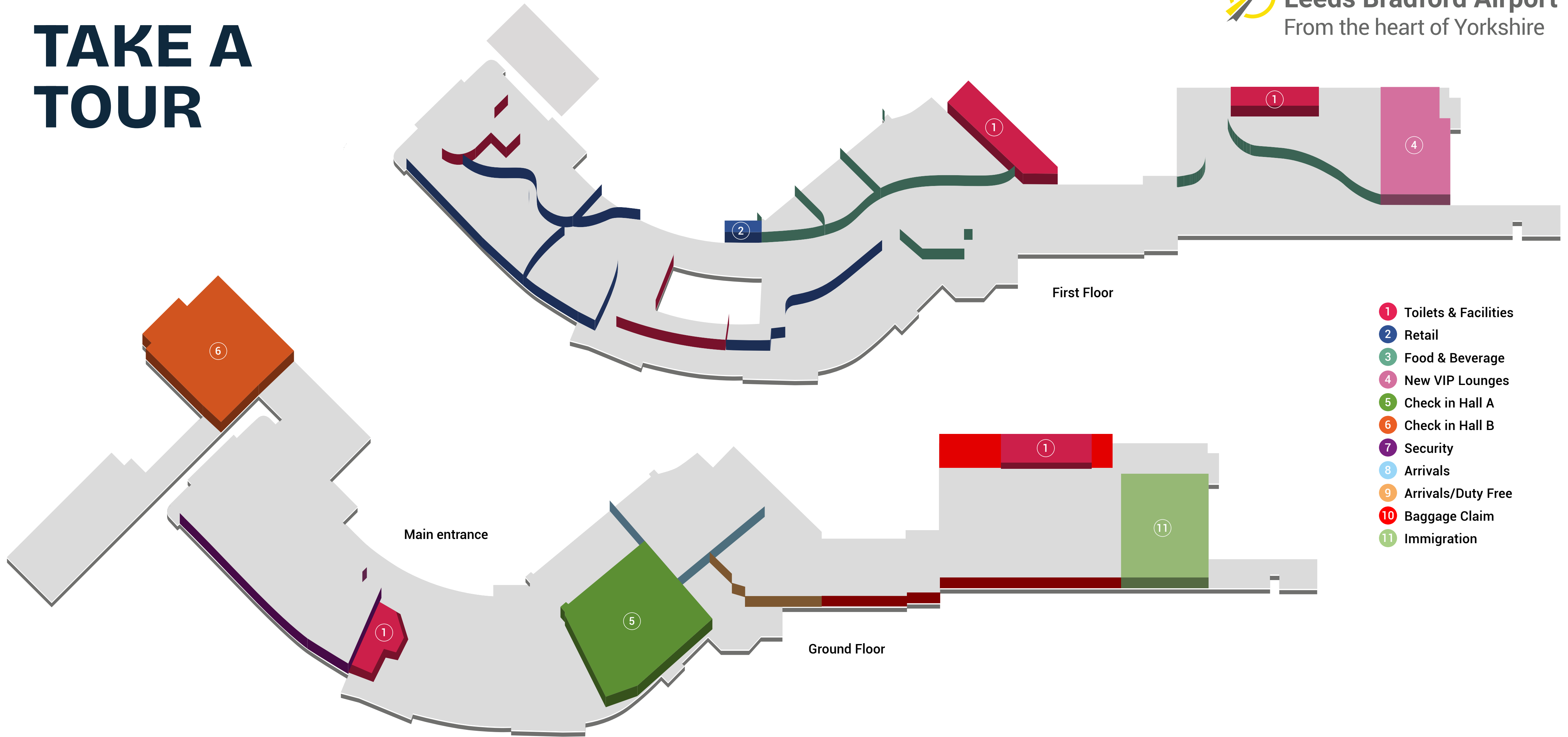

The regeneration will play a significant part in LBA's 2023 Net Zero Carbon Roadmap, with the installation of new efficient heating, lighting and machinery, including new baggage belts. With an upgraded LBA, we expect to see airlines investing in new destinations and deploying their newest, quietest and most efficient aircraft at the airport.

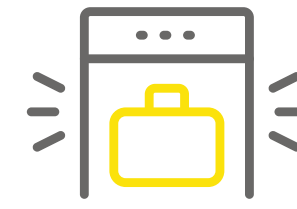

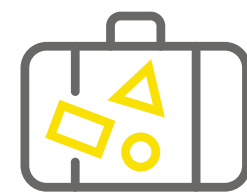

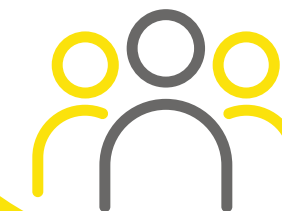

The sky is the limit

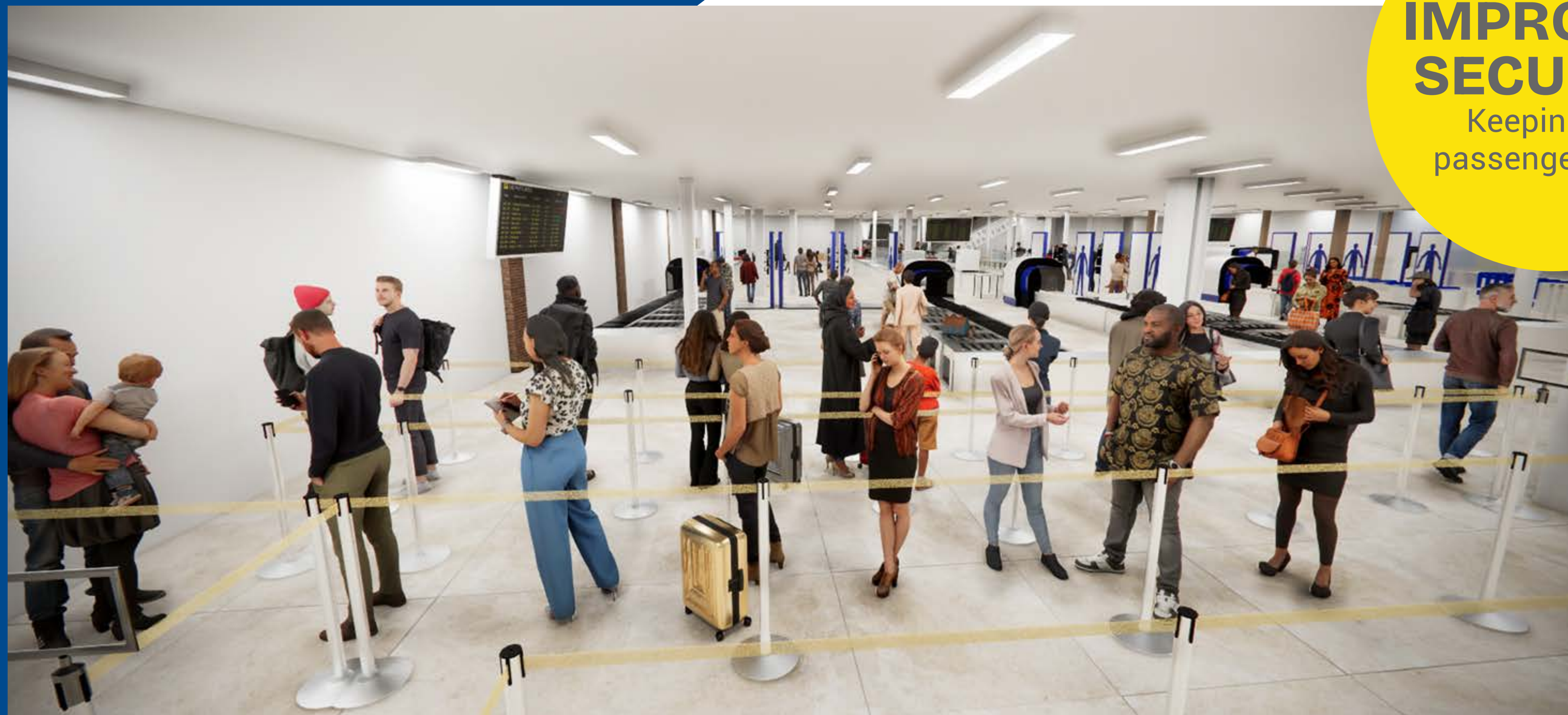
LBA:REGEN will significantly improve facilities so everyone can enjoy travelling from an airport they are proud of. The refurbishment will include simplifying the customer journey, improving accessibility, upgrading the airport lounge and expanding the retail layout. The redesign will ensure every journey delivers the full LBA experience, to be enjoyed from arrival to departure.

Passengers can expect:

- Increased capacity in security
- Improved accessibility and improved journey for passengers with reduced mobility
- 83% increase in available seats
- 76% more retail space
- 77% increase in baggage belt reclaim capacity
- 25% increase in immigration capacity

BOOSTING THE ECONOMY

Elevating future growth

LBA is a turbocharger for our region's economy and acts as an international gateway for ideas, investment and tourism. We connect the world, supporting businesses and organisations across all sectors, from advanced manufacturers to universities. Our airport is already a vital contributor to the local economy.

The regeneration provides huge potential to boost employment and the economy:

- In 2023 LBA directly employs 2100 people and indirectly supports 4500 jobs
- By completion in 2030 the regeneration has the potential to create 1500 new direct jobs at LBA and 4000 new indirect jobs
- Contributions to the local economy from £460 million in 2023 to £940 million once complete

REGIONAL PRIDE

Putting Yorkshire on the map

Yorkshire has a larger population than Scotland, Ireland and many other EU countries. As Yorkshire's leading commercial airport – this highlights how critical our +£100m investment is.

LBA:REGEN will significantly enhance the full passenger experience, securing our place as a global destination airport for years to come. This will be the first major improvement to the terminal since its opening in 1968. Upgrading LBA to the world-class facility this region deserves.
