

- 25% increase in immigration capacity






























## **Elevating future growth**

LBA is a turbocharger for our region's economy and acts as an international gateway for ideas, investment and tourism. We connect the world, supporting businesses and organisations across all sectors, from advanced manufacturers to universities. Our airport is already a vital contributor to the local economy.

The regeneration provides huge potential to boost employment and the economy:

- In 2023 LBA directly employs 2100 people and indirectly supports 4500 jobs
- By completion in 2030 the regeneration has the potential to create 1500 new direct jobs at LBA and 4000 new indirect jobs
- Contributions to the local economy from £460 million in 2023 to £940 million once complete
