(NO.46) ORDER 2014**

**AMENDMENT NO 3 ORDER 2023**

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce:-

1. No Waiting at any time on parts of:- Adel Lane, Adel Wood Close, Adel Wood Drive, Holt Avenue, Long Causeway, St Helens Lane, Adel; Glenmore Court, Leeds Road, Wynmore Avenue, Bramhope; Main Street, Manor Gardens, The Old Orchard, Pool In Wharfedale; Moseley Wood Lane, Tinshill Road, Cookridge

2. The revocation of existing items as identified in the draft Order Schedules.
