WHY **CHANGE** THE BIN COLLECTION FREQUENCY?

To help residents recycle more.

CAN I HAVE AN **EXTRA** BIN?

HOW CAN I **REDUCE** THE WASTE IN MY BLACK BIN?

If you often have too much waste for your black bin, you might be able to recycle more of it in your green bin. Additional waste, recycling and reusable items can be taken to recycling centres or banks.

## Handy Recycling Tips



For now, don't put glass in your green bin.

Use the Leeds Bins app to find your nearest glass bank. Keep an eye out for news this summer when glass can go in the green bin too.

Donate unwanted household items in good condition to charity or drop them off in the reuse container at your local household recycling centre. Put unwanted clothes and electricals in a recycling bank.
